



## **Privacy Notice and Notice of Insurance Information Practices**

FACTS	WHAT DOES NATIONAL INTERSTATE INSURANCE COMPANY AND VANLINER INSURANCE COMPANY ("NATIONAL INTERSTATE") DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:
	Social Security Number, date of birth, income;
	<ul> <li>Policy coverage, premiums, account balances, payment and claim history; and</li> </ul>
	Credit history, driving record, medical, and employment information.
	When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to operate their business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their personal information; the reasons National Interstate chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do				
How does National Interstate protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also limit access to your information to those who need it to do their jobs.			
How does National Interstate collect my personal information? Definitions				
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our affiliates include:  Financial companies within Great American Insurance Group;  Others, such as American Financial Group, Inc. and its affiliates and subsidiaries.			
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. National Interstate does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.			
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include insurance agents or other insurance licensees.

Upon your written request, we also may provide you with more information regarding the disclosure of your information.
