# Who Needs Product Recall Insurance?

A product recall event can have devastating consequences on a company's balance sheet and brand name. - **Small Appliances:** fire or burn hazard due to unsafe components and overheating
- Sporting Goods: fall hazard and injury due to defective components
- Yard and Garden/Tools: fire and laceration hazard due to defective components

## **Covered Insured Event:**

Stock recovery, market withdrawal or recall in response to the discovery of a defective or unsafe condition that has resulted in or would result in Bodily Injury or Property Damage.
